President's Message

Brothers and Sisters,

WE WERE AMONG THE OF HUNDREDS OF PEOPLE THAT TURNED OUT FOR THE CITY OF DELRAY'S MEETING TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE BANNING MOTORCYCLES IN A 5 BLOCK AREA OF ATLANTIC AVE. FROM SWINTON AVE. TO FEDERAL HWY.

THE COMMISSION HAD RECEIVED A BARRAGE OF COMPLAINTS FROM RESTAURANT OWNERS AND THEIR CUSTOMERS CLAIMING THAT THE NOISE FROM MOTORCYCLES PARKING IN FRONT OF THE OUTDOOR CAFES AND RESTAURANTS AS WELL AS THOSE PASSING BY REVVING THEIR MOTORS WAS A SERIOUS PROBLEM. THE COUNCIL APPARENTLY TOOK IT SERIOUS ENOUGH TO PROPOSE AN ORDINANCE BANNING MOTORCYCLES FROM TRAVELING DOWN ATLANTIC AVE. BETWEEN 7:00 AM AND 11:00 PM 7 DAY'S A WEEK.

A PROTEST WAS ORGANIZED BY THE ENFORCERS MC. ABATE P.B.C. AND WINGS OF GOLD MC HAD ALSO GATHERED SUPPORTERS WITHIN THEIR ORGANIZATIONS AND WERE SUPPORTED BY MEMBERS FROM LOCAL CLUBS AND INDEPENDENTS TOTALING IN THE HUNDREDS TUESDAY NIGHT 10/16 AT DELRAY BEACH CITY HALL. THE NEWS MEDIA WAS PRESENT AND SEVERAL INTERVIEWS WERE CONDUCTED THROUGHOUT THE EVENING AND AIRED THAT NIGHT ON CHANNEL 12 AND CHANNEL 5. THE SUN SENTINEL, THE PALM BEACH POST RAN STORIES AND GAVE US A RARE OPPORTUNITY TO COMMUNICATE OUR VIEWS TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

INSIDE THE CHAMBER THOSE WHO WISHED TO SPEAK WERE ASKED TO SIGN IN; THEY WERE STARTING A THIRD PAGE WHEN I SIGNED IN. THE COUNCIL APPEARED TO BE COMPLETELY AMAZED AT THE NUMBER OF MOTORCYCLISTS IN THE AUDIENCE AND THE LIST OF THREE PAGES OF PEOPLE WANTING TO SPEAK. THE COUNCIL MOVED QUICKLY THROUGH ITEMS ON THE AGENDA AND BROUGHT BEFORE US THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE WITH A GENUINE SENSE OF CONCERN. THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL SEEMED A LITTLE APPREHENSIVE AT FIRST BUT AS IT TURNED OUT THEY SPOKE VERY FRANKLY ABOUT THEIR DESIRE TO WORK WITH US BEFORE HAVING TO ENACT THE ORDINANCE AS IT WAS PROPOSED.

THIS WAS PROBABLY THE FIRST TIME ANY OF THEM HAVE EVER SEEN US FACE TO FACE. THEY SEE US ON OUR BIKES AS WE RIDE BY OR AT A LIGHT BUT THEY NEVER SEE US SITTING NEXT TO THEM AND AS DEPUTY VICE MAYOR BRENDA MONTAGUE PUT IT "JUDGING BY YOUR BEHAVIOR, YOU ARE HERE TO LISTEN, YOU'RE HERE TO HELP AND SUPPORT, AND YOU'RE HERE ALSO TO GET US TO UNDERSTAND WHAT YOU'RE FEELING. BUT I THINK IT'S MOSTLY SUPPORTED HELP". I GUESS THEY JUST DIDN'T KNOW WHAT TO EXPECT.

President's Message - Cont'd

COMMISSIONER ELIOPOULOS, WHO IS ALSO AN ARCHITECT POINTED OUT THAT THERE IS A SECTION OF ATLANTIC AVE. WITH TWO STORY BUILDINGS ON EITHER SIDE. THIS IS ALSO WHERE THE OUTSIDE CAFE'S AND RESTAURANTS ARE LOCATED. HE MENTIONED THAT ANY NOISE IS GOING TO AMPLIFIED BETWEEN THOSE BUILDINGS AND THAT'S WERE THE COMPLAINTS ARE COMING FROM. A RECOMMENDATION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER McDUFFIE TO CONDUCT A 90-DAY STUDY AND A SURVEY AND A REVIEW BEFORE ENACTING THE ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE THE BAN. IT WAS ACCEPTED UNANIMOUSLY BY THE BOARD.

COMMISSIONER McDUFFIE STATED, "THERE'S NO DOUBT THAT IN DOWNTOWN WE HAVE SOME NOISE PROBLEMS. RIGHT NOW THOSE ARE POINTED TOWARD YOU. YOU HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS THE PROBLEM". HE ALSO STATED " IF YOU WORK WITH YOUR FELLOW RIDERS AND JUST PRESENT THE FACT THAT IN DOWNTOWN DELRAY BEACH WHERE THE BUILDINGS ARE CLOSE TOGETHER PEOPLE WILL BE SITTING ON THE SIDEWALK AND THAT NOISE IS OBJECTIONABLE. I IMPLORE YOU AS COMMISSIONER OF THIS CITY SO THAT WE DON'T HAVE TO ENACT SOMETHING THAT'S KNEE- JERK LEGISLATION THAT PARTICULARLY SINGLING OUT ONE GROUP OF PEOPLE TO APPROACH THE CITY AND EMBRACE THE LAWS OF THE CITY. HE IS ASKING US, VERY SINCERELY TO HELP THEM, TO WORK WITH THEM. AN UNUSUAL BUT INTELLIGENT APPROACH TAKEN BY GOVERNMENT AT ANY LEVEL."

COMMISSIONER ELIOPOULOS ALSO COMMENTED THAT THEY WERE INUNDATED WITH EMAILS, FAXES AND PHONE CALLS FROM ALL OVER THE COUNTRY IN REGARD TO THE ORDINANCE AND BASICALLY SAID, IF YOUR ABLE TO CONTACT THAT MANY PEOPLE TO RESPOND YOU SHOULD BE ABLE TO EXPLAIN THAT WE NEED YOUR HELP TO RESOLVE THIS PROBLEM.

I FEEL THIS IS AS CLOSE AS WE MIGHT EVER GET TO ACTUALLY HAVING AN OPPORTUNITY TO HAVE A SAY IN MATTERS LIKE THIS ORDINANCE. THIS IS A TREMENDOUS OPPORTUNITY FOR US IN THE MOTORCYCLE COMMUNITY TO OPEN A LINE OF COMMUNICATION AND DISPEL A LOT OF THE MYTH AND MISUNDERSTANDINGS ASSOCIATED WITH BEING A MOTORCYCLIST. I THINK SOME OF THAT WAS EVIDENT AT CITY HALL. YOU COULD SEE THE UNEASINESS AND FEEL THE AIRE OF UNCERTAINTY FROM THE BOARD BUT I THINK IT FADED QUICKLY WHEN THEY UNDERSTOOD WHY WERE THERE IN NUMBER. A PRESENTATION WAS MADE TO A SOLDIER JUST RETURNING FROM A TOUR IN IRAQ AND WE STOOD TO APPLAUD IN HONOR. AFTER THAT THE MOOD SHIFTED TO ONE OF GENUINE OPEN COMMUNICATION OF THEIR WILLINGNESS TO WORK WITH US TO SETTLE THIS PROBLEM WITHOUT ADOPTING MORE USELESS LEGISLATION.

I THINK WE ALL KNOW IT'S NOT THE PIPES ON OUR BIKES THAT ARE LOUD IT'S THE PART THAT CONNECTS THE SEAT TO THE HANDLEBARS THAT MAKE THEM LOUD. I'M ASKING ALL OF MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS OF THE MOTORCYCLE COMMUNITY AND ESPECIALLY MEMBERS OF ABATE PALM BEACH TO JOIN WITH ME IN AN EFFORT TO EDUCATE AND COMMUNICATE WITH OTHER RIDERS THAT THIS IS NOT OVER BY A LONG SHOT. WE NEED TO BE MORE VIGILANT AND

AWARE OF THIS DURING THE NEXT 90 DAYS THAN EVER. WE NEED TO GET THE WORD OUT TO EVERYONE THAT WE NEED TO BE CONSIDERATE WHEN TRAVELING THROUGH DELRAY BEACH. USE COMMON SENSE AND BE AWARE THAT WE WILL ATTRACT EVEN MORE ATTENTION BECAUSE OF THIS NOISE ORDINANCE, PEOPLE ARE GOING TO BE STRAINING THEIR EARS TO TRY TO HEAR YOUR BIKES OVER ALL THE OTHER NOISE.

DON'T GIVE THEM THE SATISFACTION OF BEING ABLE TO GO BACK TO CITY HALL NOVEMBER 6TH WITH ALL THE AMMUNITION THEY NEED TO HALT THE STUDY AND ABANDON THE SURVEYS AND BRAKE THE LINE OF COMMUNICATION BY ENACTING THE FULL STRENGTH OF THIS ORDINANCE. THE CONSEQUENCES FOR OUR INABILITY TO USE RESTRAINT AND COMMON SENSE WHILE RIDING THROUGH DELRAY BEACH WILL WITHOUT QUESTION OPEN THE DOOR FOR EVERY MUNICIPALITY TO THE SAME. THIS WHY WE NEED TO MAKE AN ALL OUT EFFORT TO COME TOGETHER LIKE WE DID AT CITY HALL AN GATHER EVEN MORE SUPPORT FROM ALL MOTORCYCLISTS IN MAINTAINING THIS RELATIONSHIP TO AVOID ANY SIMILAR ACTIONS FROM OTHER COMMUNITIES.

IT IS MY COMMITMENT TO REPRESENT OUR CHAPTER AND ABATE OF FLORIDA, INC. IN TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THIS RARE OPPORTUNITY TO WORK WITH THE CITY OF DELRAY IN RESOLVING THIS PROBLEM OR AT LEAST PROVING TO THEM THAT WE ARE CAPABLE OF POLICING OURSELVES. I HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH CITY COMMISSIONERS AND I AM GOING TO MAKE IT MY MISSION TO DO ALL I CAN TO BRING THIS TO THE ATTENTION OF AS MANY MEMBERS OF THE MOTORCYCLE COMMUNITY AS POSSIBLE

DELRAY BEACH HAS A NOISE ORDINANCE, THEY INTEND TO ENFORCE IT AND THE PENALTY FOR LOUD PIPES IS \$200. I WOULD BE WILLING TO BET THAT THE POLICE WILL BE DIRECTED TO LOOK FOR EPA STICKERS EVEN ON OLDER BIKES WITH STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEMS IF YOU ARE STOPPED. WHAT THEY MIGHT NOT BE AWARE OF THE FACT THAT ONLY UNTIL RECENTLY DID THESE EPA STICKERS START APPEARING ON THE PIPES. IT'S NOT GOING TO BE EASY TO EXPLAIN ALL THIS WHILE THEY'RE WRITING YOU A \$200 TICKET.

PLEASE USE DISCRETION, CONSIDERATION AND COURTESY WHEN RIDING DOWN ATLANTIC AVE. A LITTLE RESPECT CAN GO A LONG WAY RIGHT NOW, LET'S NOT BLOW IT.

You may know us as the motorcycle organization that got the helmet law repealed in Florida or from our motorcycle rights and safety rally's throughout the year. ABATE of Florida is not a club, we are a motorcycle rights & safety organization dedicated to promoting motorcycle safety while remaining ever vigilant of the legislative issues concerning motorcyclists' nationwide.

THERE ARE NO MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

Because we are not a club there are no mandatory rides or meetings to attend. We do not require our members to wear our patch. If you are currently a member of a motorcycle club or any other motorcycle association or organization we welcome your support as a member.

YOUR COLORS OR PATCH ARE ALWAYS WELCOME IN OUR HOUSE

Our most recent victories include the passing of Bill HB1697 requiring stiffer penalties for a motorist turning left in front of another motorist, one of the leading causes of injury and death to motorcyclist'. A reformed bill regarding "Ape Hangers" has also been passed, handlebars are now to be measured from the riders shoulders rather than the seat. We also helped beat down legislation proposed by Senator Frank Lautenberg (D-NJ) on an amendment to the transportation, reauthorization bill (SAFE-TEA) that would re-institute a federal helmet law for all riders by denying federal transportation and safety dollars to that state

WE ARE NOT ANTI-HELMET, WE ARE ANTI-HELMET LAW

One of the most popular misconceptions about ABATE is that we are anti-helmet. Nothing could be further from the truth. We are "anti-helmet law" if you chose to ride with or without a helmet it's your choice, it is your right to decide whether wearing a helmet is right for you. ABATE is an organization fighting to protect your rights.

There are over 7,000 members of ABATE in the state of Florida with over 30 active chapters. We feel Palm Beach County has huge potential in becoming one of the largest chapters in the state. 

Vice President's Message

TIME AND TIME AGAIN THE THINGS THAT PEOPLE DO AND SAY REMIND ME THAT IT TAKES ALL KINDS TO BUILD THIS WORLD. THERE ARE LEADERS, THERE ARE FOLLOWERS, THERE ARE PEOPLE WHO TAKE ACTION, THEN THERE ARE PEOPLE WHO REACT AND THEN THERE ARE THE PEOPLE WHO JUST STAND OUTSIDE AND DIRECT TRAFFIC.





HOSPITAL GIVES MAN DRIP-FEED OF VODKA

By ASSOCIATED PRESS 10/10/07

BRISBANE, AUSTRALIA - DOCTORS PLUGGED AN ITALIAN TOURIST INTO A DRIP-FEED OF VODKA TO SAVE HIM AT A HOSPITAL IN AUSTRALIA THAT RAN OUT OF THE MEDICINAL ALCOHOL IT WOULD NORMALLY HAVE USED FOR TREATMENT.

THE 24-YEAR-OLD ITALIAN, WHO WAS NOT FURTHER IDENTIFIED, WAS BROUGHT TO MACKAY BASE HOSPITAL IN NORTHEASTERN QUEENSLAND STATE AND WAS DIAGNOSED AS HAVING INGESTED A LARGE QUANTITY OF ETHYLENE GLYCOL, A COMMON INGREDIENT OF ANTIFREEZE THAT CAN CAUSE RENAL FAILURE.

PURE ALCOHOL IS OFTEN GIVEN IN TREATING SUCH CASES BECAUSE IT CAN INHIBIT THE TOXIC EFFECTS OF ETHYLENE GLYCOL.

MACKAY BASE HOSPITAL DR. PASCAL GELPEROWICZ SAID THE MAN WAS GIVEN PHARMACEUTICAL-GRADE ALCOHOL WHEN HE ARRIVED, BUT THAT THE HOSPITAL'S SUPPLIES SOON RAN OUT.

"WE QUICKLY USED ALL THE AVAILABLE VIALS OF 100 PER CENT ALCOHOL AND DECIDED THE NEXT BEST WAY TO GET ALCOHOL INTO THE MAN'S SYSTEM WAS BY FEEDING HIM SPIRITS THROUGH A NASO GASTRIC TUBE," DR. GELPEROWICZ SAID IN A STATEMENT.

"THE PATIENT WAS DRIP-FED ABOUT THREE STANDARD DRINKS AN HOUR FOR THREE DAYS IN THE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT," HE SAID. "THE HOSPITAL'S ADMINISTRATORS WERE ALSO VERY UNDERSTANDING WHEN WE EXPLAINED OUR REASONS FOR BUYING A CASE OF VODKA."

THE PATIENT, WAS BELIEVED TO HAVE INGESTED THE POISON IN AN ATTEMPT AT SELF-HARM, MADE A SUCCESSFUL RECOVER. THE INCIDENT OCCURRED ABOUT TWO MONTHS AGO, THOUGH THE HOSPITAL JUST RELEASED INFORMATION ON THE CASE.



Done deal, PIP heads to governor

TALLAHASSEE -- THE SENATE HAS UNANIMOUSLY ADDED ITS APPROVAL TO A BILL RE-CREATING FLORIDA'S NO-FAULT AUTO INSURANCE LAW. THE LEGISLATION NOW HEADS FOR GOV. CHARLIE CRIST'S DESK FOR HIS QUICK APPROVAL INTO LAW.

THE MEASURE DOESN'T MAKE MEDICAL COVERAGE MANDATORY AGAIN UNTIL JAN. 1, BUT IT ADDS FEE SCHEDULES AND CONTROLS ON WHERE MEDICAL CARE CAN TAKE PLACE -- EFFORTS TO CRACK DOWN ON FRAUD THAT BEDEVILED THE FORMER PROGRAM THAT EXPIRED OCT. 1.

"ARE ALL OF THE SPECIAL INTERESTS HAPPY? OF COURSE THEY'RE NOT HAPPY," SAID SENATE BANKING AND INSURANCE CHAIRMAN BILL POSEY.

HE CHARACTERIZED THE HOUSE-SENATE COMPROMISE BILL AS A PLAN THAT "REDLINES THE CROOKS OUT OF THE PROCESS."

CRIST IS EXPECTED TO SIGN THE BILL QUICKLY, SAID HIS GENERAL COUNSEL, CHRIS KISE.

SEN. DAVE ARONBERG ARGUED AGAINST CONTINUING FLORIDA'S NO-FAULT LAWS, SAYING THEY UNFAIRLY PENALIZE THOSE WITH GOOD DRIVING RECORDS. NEVERTHELESS, HE VOTED FOR THE BILL.

"THE WORST SITUATION IN THE WORLD TO ME IS THE STATUS QUO, WHERE YOU HAVE NO MANDATORY INSURANCE," ARONBERG SAID.

THE RETURN OF NO-FAULT AUTO INSURANCE TO FLORIDA GOT BACK ON TRACK EARLIER WHEN HOUSE REPUBLICANS BACKED OFF THEIR EFFORTS TO USE THE BILL TO LIMIT LAWYER FEES.

THE HOUSE APPROVED RE-ENACTING NO-FAULT MEDICAL COVERAGE, ON A VOTE OF 105-4. REPS. WILL KENDRICK, DON BROWN, AARON BEAN AND CARLOS LOPEZ-CANTERA OPPOSED IT.

THE CURRENT DEAL BEFORE THE HOUSE AND SENATE REINSTATES MANDATORY MEDICAL COVERAGE AS OF THE DAY THE MEASURE IS SIGNED BY GOV. CHARLIE CRIST, AND CHANGES WHAT'S COVERED IN THAT PERSONAL INJURY PROTECTION ON JAN. 1.

THE STATE'S NO-FAULT SYSTEM ALSO WOULD RESTART ON THE DATE THE BILL BECOMES LAW.

HOWEVER, THE RE-ENACTMENT OF PIP DOESN'T AFFECT MOTORISTS WHOSE CAR INSURANCE POLICIES HAVE ALREADY RENEWED SINCE OCT. 1.

THAT LEAVES A SEGMENT OF FLORIDA'S DRIVING PUBLIC THAT, EVEN IF THEY VOLUNTARILY BUY PERSONAL INJURY PROTECTION, MUST STILL LIVE FOR FOUR MONTHS UNDER A SYSTEM TORTS - LAWSUITS FOR FAULT-FINDING IN CAR CRASHES.

ANY ACCIDENT THEY ARE INVOLVED IN CAN END IN A LAWSUIT, AGAINST EITHER THEM OR AGAINST THOSE IN THE OTHER VEHICLE.

FOR THOSE CONSUMERS, BILL AUTHOR REP. ELLYN BOGDANOFF HAS THIS ADVICE AS A PRACTICING INSURANCE AGENT.

"BUY MORE UNINSURED MOTORISTS COVERAGE. YOU MIGHT WANT TO PROTECT YOURSELF," SHE SAID.

FLORIDA INSURERS WILL ADAPT TO WHATEVER THE LEGISLATURE PASSES, SAID SAM MILLER, VICE PRESIDENT OF THE FLORIDA INSURANCE COUNCIL, ONE OF THE INDUSTRY'S STATE TRADE GROUPS.

THEY MUST CONTEND WITH THE PROSPECT OF HANDLING CLAIMS INVOLVING DIFFERENT MEDICAL COVERAGE AND EVEN DIFFERING LEGAL SYSTEMS.

"COMPANIES WORK WITH THAT IN THE VAST MAJORITY OF STATES," SAID MILLER. "NATIONAL INSURERS KNOW EXACTLY HOW THE TORT SYSTEM WORKS."



BIKERS PROTEST, PUERTO RICO SUSPENDS CONTROVERSIAL NEW LAW A DAY AFTER BEING IMPLEMENTED, THE TOUGHEST MOTORCYCLE LAW IN THE COUNTRY WAS SUSPENDED BY PUERTO RICO'S LEGISLATURE AFTER BIKERS PROTESTED THE ONEROUS NEW RULES.

AMONG THE REQUIREMENTS; RIDERS ON THE SUN-SOAKED TROPICAL ISLAND MUST WEAR GLOVES, BOOTS AND LONG PANTS. IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIRED RIDING GEAR, THE LAW WOULD ALSO FORCE OPERATORS OF ALL TWO-WHEELED MOTOR VEHICLES, INCLUDING MOPEDS AND SCOOTERS, TO WEAR REFLECTIVE VESTS FROM 6 P.M. - 6 A.M. THE U.S. TERRITORY ALREADY HAS A HELMET LAW. THE NEW LAW ALSO SLASHES THE LEGAL BLOOD ALCOHOL CONTENT (BAC) FOR MOTORCYCLE RIDERS TO .02, THE SAME AS FOR SCHOOL BUS AND COMMERCIAL TRUCK DRIVERS, DOWN FROM .08 ALLOWED FOR CAR DRIVERS. NO ONE UNDER 18 IS ALLOWED TO OPERATE A MOTORCYCLE, AND NO ONE UNDER 12 IS ALLOWED TO RIDE AS A PASSENGER. THE CARIBBEAN ISLAND ALSO ENACTED A TOUGHER LICENSING PROCESS AND INCREASED FEES FOR MOTORCYCLE ENDORSEMENTS AND REGISTRATIONS. LANE-SHARING TO FILTER THROUGH HEAVY TRAFFIC IS NOW SPECIFICALLY PROHIBITED.

MOTORCYCLE AND SCOOTER REGISTRATIONS IN PUERTO RICO HAVE MORE THAN DOUBLED SINCE 2000, AND SPONSORS OF THE MEASURE SAY THE TOUGHER REGULATIONS ARE IN RESPONSE TO INCREASING NUMBERS OF ACCIDENTS AND FATALITIES.

GOVERNOR ANIBAL ACEVEDO VILA SIGNED THE BILL INTO LAW ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 10, AMID THE ROAR OF HUNDREDS OF BIKERS REVVING BY HIS SAN JUAN RESIDENCE IN PROTEST, AND ON THURSDAY THE LEGISLATURE MOVED TO TEMPORARILY SUSPEND THE NEW LAW. THE SENATE UNANIMOUSLY BACKED A MORATORIUM ON THE LAW UNTIL FEB. 18, AND THE HOUSE APPROVED PLANS TO DELAY ITS IMPLEMENTATION FOR AT LEAST THREE MONTHS, AS LEGISLATORS TOLD THE ASSOCIATED PRESS THEY NEED MORE TIME TO CONSULT SCOOTER AND MOTORCYCLE ENTHUSIASTS WHO OBJECT TO THE STRICTER RULES.

BIKERS BLOCK BIKE BAN SCORES OF ANGRY BIKERS PACKED INTO CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS OCTOBER 16TH TO PROTEST A PROPOSED BAN ON MOTORCYCLES IN A FASHIONABLE SECTION OF DOWNTOWN DELRAY BEACH IN SOUTHERN FLORIDA, AND IN THE END MOST OF THEM CAME AWAY HAPPY.

AFTER HEARING TESTIMONY AND ACRIMONY FROM THE CROWD OF LEATHER-CLAD ACTIVISTS, CITY OFFICIALS INSTEAD VOTED UNANIMOUSLY TO AMEND A NOISE ABATEMENT LAW ALREADY IN PLACE THAT WOULD PLACE STIFF FINES ON NOISY MOTORCYCLES. THEY ALSO DECIDED TO COMMISSION A STUDY TO FIND OUT HOW MUCH OF THE NOISE ON ATLANTIC AVENUE CAN BE BLAMED ON MOTORCYCLES AND HOPE TO HAVE RESULTS IN 90 DAYS.

THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE WOULD HAVE PROHIBITED MOTORCYCLES FROM 7 A.M. TO 11 P.M. ON FIVE BLOCKS OF SHOPS AND RESTAURANTS ALONG ATLANTIC AVENUE, IN RESPONSE TO NUMEROUS COMPLAINTS ABOUT NOISY MOTORCYCLES CRUISING THE CAFE-LINED CORRIDOR.

MAYOR RITA ELLIS HAD SAID THE BAN WAS NECESSARY BECAUSE THE CITY'S NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCE WAS UNENFORCEABLE DOWNTOWN, WHERE OFFICERS ON FOOT PATROL CAN'T EASILY CHASE AFTER VIOLATORS, BUT THE MEASURE DREW OUTRAGE FROM THE MOTORCYCLE COMMUNITY BOTH LOCALLY AND ACROSS THE COUNTRY.

"I FEEL DELRAY BEACH IS INFRINGING ON MY RIGHTS," SAID JIMBO SHERROW OF THE MOTORCYCLE RIGHTS GROUP ABATE OF FLORIDA, INC. "THERE IS A STATE STATUTE THAT SAYS THEY CANNOT DO THIS."

AFTER SOME DELIBERATION, CITY COMMISSIONERS PUT A CALL OUT TO MOTORCYCLE CLUBS AND ASSOCIATIONS FOR HELP IN TRYING TO FIGURE OUT A SOLUTION WITHOUT RESORTING TO AN OUTRIGHT BAN ON MOTORCYCLES.

ARIZONA TOWN NOT SO CARE FREE ABOUT NOISE CAREFREE, ARIZONA HAS BEEN ON THE BIKERS' RADAR SCREEN FOR THEIR CONTROVERSIAL NOISE ORDINANCE, BUT NOW THE TOWN COUNCIL HAS VOTED UNANIMOUSLY TO LOWER SPEED LIMITS ON ITS MAIN THOROUGHFARE, AND ELEVATE NOISE INFRACTIONS FOR FIRST-TIME OFFENDERS FROM A CIVIL CITATION TO A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR AND POSSIBLE JAIL TIME.

THE CHANGES TAKE EFFECT IN NOVEMBER AND TARGETS MOTORCYCLES THAT EXCEED AN 85-DECIBEL NOISE LIMIT. INSTEAD OF A \$175 TICKET, VIOLATORS CAN BE FINED AS MUCH AS \$2,500 AND SENTENCED TO UP TO 180 DAYS IN JAIL.

IN ADDITION TO BEEFING UP PUNISHMENT TO CRACK DOWN ON NOISY BIKES, THE COUNCIL ALSO VOTED TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT ON CAVE CREEK ROAD, THE GATEWAY BETWEEN PHOENIX AND BARS IN DOWNTOWN CAVE CREEK, FROM 35MPH DOWN TO 25MPH.

CONGRESS FORMS MOTORCYCLE CAUCUS THE U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES HAS FORMED A MOTORCYCLE SAFETY CAUCUS, AND RIDERS ARE URGED TO CONTACT THEIR

MOTORCYCLE-FRIENDLY REPS AND ASK THEM TO JOIN. A CAUCUS IS A GROUP WITHIN A LEGISLATIVE BODY THAT IS ASSEMBLED TO REPRESENT A SPECIFIC INTEREST OR INFLUENCE A PARTICULAR AREA OF POLICY. THE MOTORCYCLE CAUCUS WILL FOCUS ON WAYS THAT CONGRESS CAN IMPROVE AND ADVANCE MOTORCYCLE SAFETY EFFORTS.

TO BECOME PART OF THIS FIRST-EVER MOTORCYCLE SAFETY CAUCUS, INTERESTED HOUSE MEMBERS SHOULD CONTACT EITHER CAUCUS CO-CHAIRS, GABRIELLE GIFFORDS (D-AZ) OR MICHAEL BURGESS (R-TX).

GIFFORDS, A FRESHMAN MEMBER OF CONGRESS AND AN AVID MOTORCYCLE RIDER HERSELF, SAID "WE KNOW FROM NATIONAL STUDIES THAT IN ALMOST TWO-THIRDS OF FATAL CAR/MOTORCYCLE CRASHES, THE FAULT WAS WITH THE DRIVER OF THE CAR. WE CAN DO MORE TO ADDRESS THIS CRITICAL PROBLEM, AND PUBLIC EDUCATION IS A KEY TO BRINGING ABOUT AWARENESS AND A REDUCTION IN SUCH ACCIDENTS."

BURGESS IS A LONG TIME SUPPORTER OF MOTORCYCLING WHO SAID HE IS LOOKING FORWARD TO WORKING WITH MOTORCYCLISTS ACROSS THE COUNTRY ON MOTORCYCLE SAFETY, EDUCATION AND AWARENESS ISSUES.

MORE AMERICANS BUCKLE UP AND WEAR HELMETS A NEW FOCUS ON MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AND INCREASED EFFORTS TO ENCOURAGE SEATBELT USE ARE PAYING OFF, ACCORDING TO U.S. TRANSPORTATION SECRETARY MARY E. PETERS, WHO SAID NEW FIGURES RELEASED RECENTLY SHOW THE NATIONAL SEAT BELT USE RATE INCREASED TO AN ALL TIME HIGH AND MORE MOTORCYCLISTS ARE WEARING THEIR HELMETS.

ACCORDING TO THE ANNUAL NATIONAL OCCUPANT PROTECTION USE SURVEY (NOPUS), AN ADDITIONAL THREE MILLION MORE AMERICANS WORE SEAT BELTS LAST YEAR AS SEAT BELT USE ROSE TO 82.4%, AN INCREASE OF 1.2 PERCENTAGE POINTS. ADDITIONALLY, THE SURVEY SHOWED THAT MOTORCYCLE HELMET USE INCREASED 7 PERCENTAGE POINTS TO 58%.

NHTSA ADMINISTRATOR NICOLE R. NASON TOLD A NATIONAL HIGHWAY SAFETY CONFERENCE IN PORTLAND, OREGON, THAT THE NEW DATA SHOW THE GREATEST RISE IN MOTORCYCLE HELMET USE OCCURRED IN THE SOUTH, WHICH ROSE BY 13 PERCENTAGE POINTS TO 58%. HELMET USE ROSE BY 11 PERCENTAGE POINTS IN THE NORTHEAST TO 58% AND BY 5 PERCENTAGE POINTS IN THE WEST TO 77%. HOWEVER, HELMET USE FELL BY 1 PERCENTAGE POINT IN THE MIDWEST TO 49%.

"MOTORCYCLE SAFETY IS A PRIORITY AT THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION AND WE ARE LOOKING AT ALL OPTIONS TO REDUCE MOTORCYCLE FATALITIES," SAID NASON.

MOTORCYCLES TO REMAIN LESS THAN 100 HP IN FRANCE BAD NEWS FOR FRENCH MOTORCYCLE RIDERS. THE ALMIGHTY AND POWERFUL EUROPEAN COMMISSION HAS RULED THAT FRANCE IS IN ITS LEGAL RIGHTS TO LIMIT MOTORCYCLE POWER TO 100 HORSEPOWER.

THE FRENCH ASSOCIATION OF ANGRY BIKERS (FFMC -- FEDERATION FRANCAISE DES MOTARDS EN COLERE) SUED THE FRENCH STATE AND TOOK THEM TO THE EUROPEAN COURTS.

APPARENTLY, HAVING UNIFORM LAWS IN EUROPE ONLY APPLY TO ANYTHING EXCEPT MOTORCYCLES, SAID THE FFMC ABOUT THE RULING. THE EC STATED THAT EACH COUNTRY COULD IMPOSE THEIR OWN RESTRICTIONS.

THE FFMC COUNTERED THAT AN EXTENSIVE STUDY BY DUTCH TNO SHOWED NO CORRELATION BETWEEN ACCIDENTS AND MOTORCYCLES WITH MORE POWER THAN 100 H.P.

SO RIDING IN FRANCE ON A FRENCH-REGISTERED MOTORCYCLE MEANS YOU CAN ONLY HAVE 100 H.P., WHILE ANYONE ELSE RIDING IN FRANCE CAN RIDE WHATEVER THEY WANT, ON THE SAME ROAD, WITH THE SAME TRAFFIC, AND CARS ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THE RESTRICTION.

THE FFMC VOWS THAT THEY ARE NOT GOING TO LET THIS GO. STAY TUNED!

BIKER HAS DIFFICULTY GETTING LICENSE REINSTATED HOWARD BURLEY LOVES HIS HARLEY-DAVIDSON. THAT'S EXACTLY WHY THE ARIZONA BIKER HASN'T OWNED A CAR IN MORE THAN A DECADE. "YOU LOVE THE FEEL -- THE VIBRATIONS AND STUFF LIKE THAT," HE TOLD 3TV REPORTER GARY HARPER OF 3 ON YOUR SIDE.

BUT LAST YEAR, BURLEY WAS ARRESTED FOR DRUNK DRIVING. IT WAS A HUGE MISTAKE, BUT HE SAID HE LEARNED FROM IT, AND EVEN CLAIMS THE DUI HAS MADE HIM A BETTER MAN THESE DAYS. "ABSOLUTELY. I QUIT DRINKING. I GO THROUGH ALCOHOL CLASSES. IT WAS DEFINITELY A WAKE UP CALL," HE SAID.

BURLEY SERVED JAIL TIME, PAID ALL OF HIS COURT COSTS AND FINES AND SAID HE'S CLEANED UP HIS LIFE. THE ONLY THING HE WANTS NOW IS FOR HIS DRIVER'S LICENSE TO BE REINSTATED BY MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION.

TO DO THAT, MVD SAID ALL HE HAS TO DO IS INSTALL AN IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE. DRIVERS HAVE TO BLOW INTO IT AT RANDOM TIMES TO MAKE SURE THEY'RE NOT DRINKING WHILE THEY'RE DRIVING. IF THE DRIVER HAS BEEN DRINKING, THE DEVICE PREVENTS THE CAR FROM STARTING UP.

"THE ONLY PROBLEM IS THEY DO NOT PUT THEM ON MOTORCYCLES," BURLEY SAID. AND A MOTORCYCLE IS ALL THAT BURLEY OWNS. IF HE WANTS TO GET HIS LICENSE BACK, HE SAID MVD TOLD HIM HE'LL HAVE TO BUY A CAR.

ORGANIZATIONS LIKE THE ARIZONA CONFEDERATION OF MOTORCYCLE CLUBS SAY BURLEY'S SITUATION IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF MOTORCYCLE DISCRIMINATION. "IT'S ANOTHER WAY THE

GOVERNMENT IS FORCING YOU INTO SOMETHING YOU DON'T WANT TO DO," SAID STEVEN MUSGRAVE WITH THE ARIZONA CONFEDERATION OF MOTORCYCLE CLUBS.

ALTHOUGH SOME STATES DO ALLOW MOTORCYCLES TO HAVE THE DEVICE, ARIZONA DOES NOT. FOR NOW, THE STATE SAID IT'S NOT PLANNING ON USING THE DEVICE ON MOTORCYCLES.

BURLEY SAID HE AND NUMEROUS MOTORCYCLE ORGANIZATIONS THAT LOBBY LAWMAKERS ARE MONITORING THE SITUATION TO SEE IF CHANGES MIGHT BE MADE IN THE FUTURE. IN THE MEANTIME, HE'S RESORTED TO TAKING THE BUS AND CAN ONLY HOPE THE MVD WILL CHANGE ITS MIND.

TOLKIN PENNED "1%" AND IS EXEC PRODUCING THE PILOT WITH MANAGEMENT 360'S ALEX HERTZBERG AND GUYMON CASADY.
