President's Message

Brothers and Sisters,

I HOPE EVERYONE ENJOYED THE HOLIDAYS. HAPPY NEW YEAR TO ONE AND ALL.

NOW THAT THE NEW YEAR HAS BEGUN IT'S TIME TO PLAN OUR COURSE. AS I HAD MENTIONED LAST MONTH THE LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS WILL BE OPENING AND THERE ARE GOING TO BE SOME INHERENT CHALLENGES AS WELL AS SOME NEW ONES, WHICH SHOULD PROVE TO BE SOME VERY INTERESTING TIMES FOR US AS A GRASSROOTS POLITICAL ORGANIZATION.

THE NEW FACES IN GOVERNMENT WILL UNDOUBTEDLY BE OVERWHELMED FOR A WHILE CONSIDERING A NEW PRESIDENT WILL BE TAKING OFFICE AND LORD ONLY KNOWS WHAT HE'S GOT IN MIND. THE WORDS ALREADY OUT AS TO HIS STAND ON THE SECOND AMENDMENT AND THIS LEADS ME TO BELIEVE THERE IS A BATTLE ON THE HORIZON REGARDING OTHER PERSONAL RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS. FROM MY OWN PERSONAL OBSERVATIONS WHENEVER YOU HAVE A NEW ADMINISTRATION COMING IN, THERE WILL BE THOSE WHO WANT TO MAKE THEIR MARK AND A NAME FOR THEMSELVES AMONG THEIR CONSTITUENTS. SOME WILL GO TO THE EXTREME AND THE OVERZEALOUS ONES ARE ALWAYS GOING TO POSE A PROBLEM. THESE ARE THE ONE'S WE NEED TO IDENTIFY AND PAY SPECIAL ATTENTION TO RIGHT FROM THE START, BECAUSE WHILE THEIR HEADS ARE A BOBBIN' YES, THEY ARE ALSO EAGER TO SHOW THEIR POLITICAL SAVVY AND NEW IDEAS TO FIX EVERYTHING, THEY FORGET WE TOO ARE THEIR CONSTITUENTS AND THE ONES WHO PUT THEM THERE.

I CANNOT IMPRESS UPON YOU ENOUGH, HOW IMPORTANT IT WILL BE TO ESTABLISH COMMUNICATION AND DIALOG WITH THE POWERS THAT BE, IMMEDIATELY. NOT JUST ON THE STATE AND NATIONAL LEVEL, BUT ALSO ON THE LOCAL LEVEL. PERHAPS, THE LATTER AS OUR FIRST OBJECTIVE TO KIND OF GET A FEEL FOR WHAT WE'RE UP AGAINST. THIS WILL INDEED PROVE HOW EFFECTIVE OUR STRATEGIES WILL BE AS WE PROGRESS.

FOR OPENERS, ONE OF THE MOST CRITICAL ISSUES THAT MUST BE ADDRESSED WILL BE THE RIGHT OF WAY VIOLATORS (R.O.W.V.) A COUPLE WEEKS BEFORE CHRISTMAS A NEWS ARTICLE WAS SENT TO ME ABOUT THREE MOTORCYCLE OFFICERS IN BROWARD COUNTY THAT WERE INJURED IN TWO SEPARATE INCIDENTS ONLY TWO HOURS APART. THE FIRST INVOLVED AN SUV AND A SINGLE MOTORCYCLE OFFICER THE SECOND, TWO OFFICERS AND ANOTHER SUV. ON THE DAY THE AMERICAN LEGION RIDERS 268 PRESENTED A CHECK TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE VA HOSPITAL, I LEARNED THAT ONE OF THEIR MEMBERS WAS HIT IN WELLINGTON THE SAME WEEK.

I SPOKE WITH ONE OF OUR OWN MEMBERS WHO WORKS IN LAW ENFORCEMENT AND TOLD HIM ABOUT THESE INCIDENTS. THERE ARE SEVERAL MOTORCYCLE CLUBS AND RIDING ORGANIZATIONS WITH MEMBERS THAT ALSO WORK IN LAW ENFORCEMENT OR RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS. I SUGGESTED THAT THIS MIGHT BE THE TIME TO GET TOGETHER AND FORM A COALITION TO WORK TOWARD GETTING "STIFFER PENALTY" LEGISLATION ON THE TABLE AND HAVE IT SUPPORTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT STATEWIDE. IT'S OBVIOUS THIS PROBLEM IS AFFECTING THEM AS WELL AND

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE - CONT'D

BECAUSE OF THE GROWING NUMBER OF THESE INCIDENTS BEING REPORTED IT HAS BECOME CLEAR THAT THIS PROBLEM IS AFFECTING ALL MOTORISTS NOT JUST MOTORCYCLISTS. I SEE THIS AS A GREAT OPPORTUNITY TO GET ANOTHER SEGMENT OF THE MOTORCYCLE COMMUNITY INVOLVED IN BRINING OUR MESSAGE TO THOSE THAT JUST MIGHT LISTEN A LITTLE CLOSER WHEN THEY HEAR IT FROM PEOPLE THAT DEAL WITH THIS EVERY DAY.

I BELIEVE IF WE CAN GAIN THE SUPPORT IN WORKING WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT TO ADDRESS THE R.O.W.V. ISSUE, IT JUST MIGHT GIVE US A LITTLE MORE OF AN ADVANTAGE IN REACHING THE PUBLIC IN OTHER ASPECTS OF TEACHING SAFE AND RESPONSIBLE DRIVING HABITS. WE HAVE A "SAFETY PROGRAM" THAT NEEDS TO BE ACTIVATED, I CAN'T THINK OF A BETTER WAY TO GET THE ATTENTION OF YOUNG PEOPLE AND THE COMMUNITY THAN TO HELP THEM UNDERSTAND THAT WE ARE WORKING CLOSELY WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT TO EDUCATE THEM AND HOPEFULLY THEIR PARENTS AS TO THE DANGERS DIRECTLY RELATED TO CELL PHONE USE AND TEXT MESSAGING WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE OF ANY KIND. I'M SURE MOST OF THEM HAVE NEVER HEARD THE TERM "INATTENTIONAL BLINDNESS" AND IT'S DEADLY CONSEQUENCES. IT'S LIKELY THEIR PARENTS HAVE NEVER HEARD IT EITHER AND NEED TO BE ABLE TO EXPLAIN IT IN TERMS THAT CAN SAVE THEIR LIVES AND THE LIVES OF OTHERS.

TO KICK OFF THE NEW YEAR WE WILL BE FORMING COMMITTEES TO CONCENTRATE ON ADDRESSING THE THREE MOST IMPORTANT ISSUES IN SUPPORT OF THE AGENDA SET FORTH BY THE ABATE STATE BOARD FOR 2009, R.O.W.V. (RIGHT OF WAY VIOLATIONS) AMENDING THE CURRENT "STIFFER PENALTIES" LAW, REINSTATING MANDATORY DRIVER EDUCATION COURSES IN THE FLORIDA SCHOOL SYSTEM STATEWIDE AND A BAN ON CELL PHONE USE WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE OF ANY KIND. I AM HOPING TO SEE MORE OF OUR MEMBERS BECOME ACTIVE TO HELP US FORM COMMITTEES AND WORK TO GET OUR MESSAGE TO THE COMMUNITY AND CIVIC LEADERS ON THE LOCAL LEVEL IN HOPES OF GAINING THEIR SUPPORT AND INFLUENCE TO TAKE THESE ISSUES TO OUR STATE REPRESENTATIVES.

IF YOU BELIEVE IN MOTORCYCLISTS RIGHTS, SAFETY AND AWARENESS, YOU NEED TO JOIN ABATE OF FLORIDA. OUR CHAPTER HOLDS ITS MEETINGS ON THE THIRD SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH (SEE THE BACK COVER FOR TIME AND DATE) YOU'RE WELCOME TO STOP BY, THERE IS NO OBLIGATION TO JOIN AND THERE ARE NO MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS, YOUR LEVEL OF INVOLVEMENT IS ENTIRELY UP TO YOU.



VICE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

HAVE YOU EVER BEEN RIDING ALONG AND NOTICED HOW BIRDS FLOCK AROUND A TRACTOR CHURNING THE EARTH FOR PLANTING OR HARVESTING?

I'VE EVEN NOTICED THEM FOLLOWING THE LARGE TRACTORS MOWING ALONG THE TURNPIKE OF SOME OF THE MORE RURAL ROUTES OUT WEST. YOU SEE, AS THE TRACTORS TURN UP THE EARTH OR MOW THE GRASS, THEY UNCOVER FOOD SOURCES FOR THE BIRDS AND THEY HAVE REALIZED THAT THEY CAN FOLLOW AND BENEFIT FROM SOMEONE ELSE'S HARD WORK. WELL. IT IS TIME FOR SOME OF OUR FLOCK TO STOP FOLLOWING THE TRACTOR AND HOP UP INTO THE DRIVER'S SEAT. WHAT I MEAN BY THAT IS NOW THAT OUR CHAPTER HAS OVER THREE YEARS UNDER OUR BELT AND CONSIDERING THAT WE NOW HAVE ALMOST 300 MEMBERS THERE IS NO REASON FOR ANY OF OUR BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO BE HOLDING MORE THAN ONE BOARD POSITION. THE BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES ARE TOO IMPORTANT FOR ANY ONE PERSON TO BE DOING MORE THAN ONE. IT ALSO HAPPENS TO BE IN CONTRADICTION OF THE BY-LAWS OF ABATE OF FLORIDA. WHEN WE WERE A YOUNG CHAPTER WITH FEW MEMBERS IT MAY HAVE BEEN NECESSARY BUT NOT NOW.

THE PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, SECRETARY AND TREASURER COMPRISE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICERS OF THE CHAPTER. THEN THERE ARE EIGHT (8) TRUSTEES; SERGEANT AT ARMS, MEMBERSHIP, NEWSLETTER, PUBLIC RELATIONS, PRODUCTS, 2 STATE DELEGATES/LEGISLATIVE AND AT THE LAST STATE MEETING THE POSITION OF SAFETY DIRECTOR BECAME AN ELECTED TRUSTEE POSITION.
