

Another bit of good news from the last state meeting was that Law Tigers will be sponsoring us with a financial sponsorship and they will be handling our legal affairs in the future.

Don't forget that we will have a booth at the Palm Beach motorcycle expo on November 22-23. A good showing of members would be greatly appreciated as well as those of you who would be willing to donate your time at the booth.

Another reminder of great importance is that our Annual fundraiser is coming up on December 7th. It will be held at The Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie 4219 where we have our meetings. 
A new year is approaching, let's boost membership, stand strong and be a force with which to be reckoned!

# DELEGATES' REPORT

October 11 2025

Gator Alley Chapter

Gator Alley hosted our October Delegate meeting. Thank you for a great lunch.

We opened the meeting with a presentation from FWD Consulting Group. A husband and wife team with what seemed to be our best choice for our new lobbyist firm.

A vote was taken to hire FWD Consulting Group to represent us in Tallahassee.

The State poker run is to be called the Run In The Sun. It will be held on April 11th. Each Chapter is responsible for their own rules. With the final stop at Veterans Village in Fort McCoy near Ocala. A \$20.00 entry fee for each player. Each chapter will donate a bottle to be sold back to us at the Saturday night party. This is a fund raiser for ABATE of Florida. It is also a good way to meet the people of the other chapters. There are onsite cabins, camping and camper hookup or hotels in Ocala.

The Law Tigers will be our new legal counsel. They have committed \$10,000 to sponsor us.

The State party will be at Scooter Haven the second week in October 2026.

A vote to raise the membership to thirty dollars with twenty going to the state and ten to the chapter did not pass. A new motion was made to raise the membership to thirty dollars with a 50/50 split between the state and the chapters. A motion was made to lower the lifetime membership to four hundred and fifty dollars. A vote will be taken at the December 13th meeting at Fort McCoy.

## 2026 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA


In September, at the 2025 Motorcycle Riders Foundation's (MRF) 41st Annual Meeting of the Minds Conference held in Shreveport, LA, a legislative strategy session was hosted by the MRF's Legislative Committee. The purpose of the session was to establish and prioritize the MRF's 2026 Federal Legislative Agenda.

Legislative issues fall into one of three priority categories: high, medium and monitor. This list remains fluid and may be adapted depending on the issue or political environment.

Below is a brief description of just the top 12 issues on the MRF's 2026 agenda listed as "High Priority." The January 2026 issue of the American Biker Journal will have more details on each of these High Priority issues, as well as the full list of an additional 12 priorities that fall in the "Medium" or "Monitor" classification.

### The 2026 Motorcycle Riders Foundation Legislative Priorities List

#### HIGH PRIORITY OBJECTIVES:

- **Autonomous Vehicles:** Advocate and monitor any legislation or regulations related to motorcycles concerning connected and autonomous vehicles.
- **Crash Avoidance:** Continue to promote the theme of crash avoidance versus safer crashing, urging the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) to focus on crash prevention and support rider education by providing funding and other resources.
- **Data Recording:** Pursue legislative language that any collected or available vehicle data is the property of the consumer and in which the consumer has the choice of whether to opt-in to having their personal data communicated to interested parties.

- **Definition of a Motorcycle:** Educate policymakers and advocate for change to the current definition that better reflects the current two and three-wheel motorcycle landscape.
- **Emission Regulations:** Engage the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) & Congress on any activity related to motorcycle emission regulations.
- **Helmet Laws/Equipment Mandates:** Oppose any mandatory federal helmet or personal protective equipment/apparel mandates.
- **Internal Combustion Engines:** Work to ensure the survival of internal combustion engines.
- **Profiling:** Sustain lobbying efforts for the passage of resolutions or legislation that promote awareness and the prohibition of motorcyclist profiling.
- **Renewable Fuels:** Advocate for targeted changes to the Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS).
- **Right to Repair/Modify:** Protect and advocate for “Right to Repair” provisions that allow consumers the ability to repair and modify their motorcycles.
- **Surface Transportation Reauthorization (Highway Bill):** Advocate and pursue legislative efforts related to the next highway bill reauthorization (the current act is set to expire in 2026).
- **Vulnerable Roadway User Terminology:** Monitor and ensure that motorcycles and motorcyclists are a specific and unique category or classification.

## NHTSA LAUNCHES NEW TESLA INVESTIGATION

This month, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) opened a new investigation into Tesla following reports that vehicles equipped with the company’s “Full Self-Driving” (FSD) system violated traffic laws while operating under partial automation. According to NHTSA, the agency is aware of 58 separate incidents, including cases where Teslas drove through red lights, traveled the wrong way on roads, and were involved in crashes and injuries.

The preliminary evaluation encompasses approximately 2.9 million





vehicles equipped with the FSD system. While no fatalities have been linked to these incidents, NHTSA identified at least six crashes in which Teslas continued through red lights and collided with other vehicles. Several of these incidents reportedly occurred at the same Maryland intersection, where Tesla has since taken corrective measures.

This new probe adds to NHTSA's growing list of investigations into Tesla's driver-assistance technology, which includes inquiries into its Autopilot features, vehicle doors, and crash reporting practices. Federal regulators have also questioned the system's ability to handle poor visibility and other real-world driving challenges.

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) continues to closely monitor these developments, as autonomous technology remains a key issue within the recently approved 2026 MRF Legislative Agenda. Ensuring that emerging vehicle technologies are safely deployed and properly regulated is essential to protecting all road users, especially motorcyclists.

The MRF will continue to advocate for transparency, accountability, and rigorous oversight in the rollout of self-driving vehicle systems.

## **MRF NOMINATES JAY JACKSON MOTORCYCLIST ADVISORY COUNCIL**

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) is proud to announce the formal nomination of MRF Vice President Jay Jackson of Indiana to serve on the U.S. Department of Transportation's Motorcyclist Advisory Council (MAC). Jay has been nominated for the seat reserved for a representative of a national motorcyclist foundation.

The MAC provides the U.S. Department of Transportation with essential feedback on infrastructure design, roadway safety, and other issues directly impacting motorcyclists. The MRF has long believed that riders deserve a strong and informed voice in these discussions, and Jay Jackson's nomination reflects that commitment to representation and expertise at the federal level.

Jay was previously appointed to an earlier version of the MAC. With the reconstitution of the Council requiring new nominations, the MRF is once again honored to put Jay forward to continue his service on behalf of America's riders.

A motorcyclist for more than 50 years with hundreds of thousands of miles on the road, Jay brings unmatched firsthand knowledge of the challenges and opportunities facing riders. Professionally, he has devoted decades to improving rider safety, education, and advocacy. As State Director of

the Motorcycle Safety Division for ABATE of Indiana, Jay has overseen one of the nation's largest rider education programs for over 25 years, while also serving as a certified instructor since 1986. His leadership has helped train thousands of new riders and strengthen the culture of safety across the country.

On the national stage, Jay has served on the Executive Committee of the State Motorcycle Safety Association and as the MRF's Director of Motorcycle Safety, helping shape the Foundation's training and policy initiatives. His deep understanding of both rider issues and the policymaking process makes him an exceptional candidate for the Council.

Jay's nomination has earned overwhelming support from across the motorcycling community. Nearly 40 state motorcyclist rights organizations from around the country joined together to endorse his candidacy. In addition, letters of recommendation have been submitted by U.S. Senator Todd Young (R-IN); the Co-Chairs of the Congressional Motorcycle Caucus, Reps. Tim Walberg (R-MI) and Troy Balderson (R-OH); New Hampshire Speaker of the House Sherm Packard (R-NH); and former MAC Chairman Michael Sayre.

MRF President Kirk Willard said, "Jay's lifetime of dedication to motorcycling, his leadership in safety and education, and his experience working with policymakers make him the ideal representative for the MRF and riders nationwide."

The MRF extends its sincere thanks to all the state motorcyclist rights organizations, lawmakers, and supporters who backed Jay's nomination. Together, we continue our shared mission, ensuring that the voice of motorcyclists remains strong, respected, and heard in Washington, D.C.


