

National COIR is free, upgrade and get insurance: Motorcycle Riders Foundation sites can be viewed at no cost and if you choose to sign up there's more insurance. These AD&D policies stack up. For a low investment you can be both insured and informed. Both of those things keep us safer and hoping to perpetuate the life and freedoms that we cherish.

Happy new year everyone! Well last month I went to the state meeting in Ocala.

First, I will start with the vote to increase our yearly and lifetime memberships. A vote was taken to increase the yearly dues from \$20.00 to \$30.00. Our chapter was in favor of this the increase which will start on January 1st 2026. As far as the lifetime memberships, they will go from \$600.00 to \$450.00 for a lifetime membership. They both were passed by our State Chapter Delegation.

Now the question on everyone's mind - who won the state raffle for the griddle? The winner was RJ Dorf from Peace River Chapter.

Now for a very important new amended FL House bill being introduced, HB-429, proposes change to gang member criteria. HB-429 would make several changes to the state statute. Among them would be considering an admission of gang membership on social media to be sufficient for prosecution. In the law as it currently reads, social media isn't contemplated. I encourage you to look this bill on the next pages.

Next state meeting will be in Tallahassee on Feb.8 in Monticello. The 29th annual Freedom Ride to the Florida State Capitol will be on Monday, Feb.9th. This year they are asking anyone who attends that can to stay until Tuesday for a Legislative meet and greet at the Capitol 8:30am meeting at 9:00am. For more info contact me or one of you board members. If you are interested in the ride to the capital, it is a truly great experience. That's all for now.



## SIGN ONLINE PETITION OPPOSING FLORIDA HB-429

December 16, 2025

Florida’s House Bill 429 (HB-429) seeks to loosen the standards required to qualify for gang membership. This bill would require a two-factor system, where meeting two of the listed criteria would qualify individuals for the criminal gang database. These criteria do not require you to have participated in criminal conduct or criminal activity. The criteria included are as simple as commenting on identified social media posts or being observed twice in the presence of anyone previously identified as a gang member.

Other criteria include adopting the style of dress of a criminal gang. However, that style of dress is not identified and left to the discretion of law enforcement. Another criterion is having a tattoo identified as used by a criminal gang. With this broad option, if a gang began using a heart-shaped tattoo, all citizens with heart tattoos would be eligible for the criminal gang database at the discretion of law enforcement.

Understandably, Florida citizens are alarmed and have started an online petition to oppose HB-429. This petition is open to everyone nationwide. The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) encourages all freedom fighters to click the button below and sign on. ## MOTORCYCLE PROFILING PROJECT 2025 SURVEY APPROACHING END DATE

December 12, 2025

One of the top recent success stories for the Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) has been the passage of Resolutions in both the House of Representatives and the Senate, denouncing the practice of profiling motorcyclists by law enforcement. One key partner in achieving these two victories was the Motorcycle Profiling Project (MPP), which conducts an annual survey of motorcy-

clists nationwide on this topic. The survey's data has been acknowledged directly within the federal legislation and proved invaluable to its passage.

The MPP survey is not for motorcyclists who have been profiled; it is for everyone who has an opinion on the topic of motorcyclist profiling. The survey is renewed annually with changes to the questions to keep it relevant. The MPP survey needs more than 10,000 people to participate each year, to maintain its margin of error at less than 1%. All active motorcyclists should take this simple five (5) question survey each year to help maintain our successes and help with future legislation.

The resolutions passed in the House of Representatives and the Senate were intended to advise states to address the issue of motorcyclist profiling. So far, five (5) states have passed laws making it illegal to initiate a stop simply because someone is on a motorcycle or wearing motorcycle attire. Several other states have bills pending or awaiting introduction in upcoming legislative sessions. Ride free!

## **CAFE ROLLBACK REOPENS DOOR FOR INTERNAL COMBUSTION CHOICE**

**December 5, 2025**

This week, President Trump announced a major rewrite of the federal Corporate Average Fuel Economy (CAFE) standards. The proposal rolls back the fuel-economy targets established during the previous administration, targets that automakers argued could not be met without a rapid shift toward electric vehicles. The administration framed the change as a return to the original purpose of CAFE, focusing on fuel efficiency, rather than forced electrification.

The move fits into a broader regulatory shift. Earlier this year, lawmakers revoked California's EPA waiver, which allowed the state to impose stricter emissions rules and effectively push zero-emission vehicle mandates. That waiver had become one of the most powerful national drivers of EV adoption, as many other states follow California's standards. Removing it, combined with the newly proposed CAFE reset, amounts to a coordinated effort to ease regulatory pressure that had been steering manufacturers away from internal-combustion engines.

For the Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF), this moment is significant. While the proposal directly affects cars and trucks, rules of





this kind are frequently expanded over time to include motorcycles, making this development especially relevant to the riding community. For the MRF, preservation of the internal-combustion engine is a core legislative priority, and the proposed standards may help maintain space in the marketplace for ICE technology. By lowering regulatory pressure on automakers, these changes could strengthen consumer access to gas-powered vehicles and slow the trend toward policy-driven electrification.

For riders, that translates into a greater likelihood that motorcycles powered by traditional engines remain affordable, viable, and widely available.

While the proposal will face public comment and probable legal challenges, the shift signals a meaningful change in federal regulatory direction. For motorcyclists who value mechanical choice and the performance characteristics of internal-combustion engines, the administration's actions may mark a favorable step toward preserving the freedom to choose how they ride.

## MOTORCYCLE RIDERS FOUNDATION 2026 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

### 2026 HIGH PRIORITY OBJECTIVES

#### **Autonomous Vehicles:**

Advocate and monitor any legislation or regulations related to motorcycles concerning connected and autonomous vehicles (AV):

- 🛡️ Endorse rulemaking to set new standards specific to seeing, detecting, and properly reacting to motorcycles.
- 🛡️ Ensure motorcycles are part of all testing and development procedures.
- 🛡️ Promote that any AV public user advisory committees should include a representative from the motorcycle community and a motorcycle manufacturer.
- 🛡️ Require a public, easily accessible, and searchable database where consumers can look up important safety information such as the limitations and capabilities of different products offered by AV manufacturers or service providers.
- 🛡️ Require that all AV manufacturers must submit safety evaluation reports to detail and make public how their vehicles identify motorcycles among other road users. Manufacturers must also include human error analysis in safety reports.
- 🛡️ Require that all AV manufacturers publicly report crash data and share incidents between AVs and motorcycles just as they would incidents between AVs and other road users.
- 🛡️ Protect the safety of motorcyclists with any rules or standards as they relate to electronic and cybersecurity systems including the clarification of rights of data ownership of any recorded data in the context of connected and autonomous vehicles.
- 🛡️ Inclusion of motorcyclists' perspectives in discussions regarding the Intelligent Transportation System

- 🛵 Work to ensure motorcycles are a separate classification of vehicle and road user for purposes of regulation and testing of AVs.
- 🛵 Protect the set aside radio spectrums necessary for Dedicated Short Range (DSRC) vehicle to vehicle communications.
- 🛵 Protect additional spectrum as needed for Vehicle to Everything technology (V2X).

**Crash Avoidance:**

Continue to promote the theme of crash avoidance versus safer crashing urging the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) to focus on crash prevention and support rider education by providing funding and other resources.

**Data Recording:**

Pursue legislative language that any collected or available vehicle data is the property of the consumer. The consumer should have the choice of whether to opt-in to having their personal data communicated to interested parties.

**Definition of a Motorcycle:**

Educate policymakers and ask for a change to the current definition that better reflects the current two and three-wheel motorcycle landscape. Collaborate with appropriate stakeholders concerning the federal definition of a motorcycle, ensuring that crash and fatality statistics continue to be separate from other classes of vehicles including autocycles, non-motorcycle powered vehicles such as mopeds, scooters, motorized bicycles, and various cabin-based steering wheel type vehicles.

**Emission Regulations:**

- 🛵 Engage the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) & Congress on any activity related to motorcycle emission regulations.
- 🛵 Work against any efforts by the California Air Resources Board (CARB) or any other agencies or boards that endanger the future of motorcycling.

**Helmet Laws/Equipment Mandates:**

Oppose any mandatory federal helmet or personal protective equipment/apparel mandates. Advocate for limiting funding of any federal government entity with increasing involvement in advocating for a universal helmet law or similar initiatives.

**Internal Combustion Engines:**

Work to ensure the survival of internal combustion engines, including elimination of the California air quality exemption waivers which allows California to enact different standards and threatens internal combustion engine production. Pursue similar policies for other state or federal agencies or boards as needed.

**Profiling:**

Sustain lobbying efforts for the passage of resolutions or legislation that promote awareness related to, and prohibit the practice of, the profiling of motorcyclists. Seek opportunities to include legislative language that:

- 🛵 Monitors and responds to federal legislative or regulatory activity concerning the usage of the terms gang, club, or any derogatory term when referring to motorcyclists.
- 🛵 Promotes increased public awareness on the issue of profiling of motorcyclists. Encourages collaboration and communication with the motorcycling community and law enforcement to engage in efforts to end profiling of motorcyclists.
- 🛵 Urges state law enforcement officials to include statements condemning profiling of motorcyclists in written policies and training materials.
- 🛵 Outlaws the practice of profiling of motorcyclists.



- 🚲 Opposes any motorcycling, motorcycle, or motorcyclist-based discriminatory legislation or rules proposed by the U.S. Congress or by any governmental agency.
- 🚲 Protects U.S. citizen motorcyclists reentering the country from undue detainment based on their associations, apparel or lifestyle.

**Renewable Fuels:**

Advocate for targeted changes to the Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS) including the following actions:

- 🚲 Support the universal availability of approved fuel blends, containing no more than 10 percent ethanol by volume.
- 🚲 Promote additional research and independent studies concerning the effects of higher blends of renewable fuels on motorcycles.
- 🚲 Ensure the availability of separate pumps (i.e., no multi-dispensing, blender pumps) to minimize the risk of damage to motorcycle engines where higher blend of renewable fuel blends is available.
- 🚲 Sustain lobbying efforts for the passage of legislation which requires information to be provided to the public about the risks associated with the improper use of E15 fuel (or higher) in certain vehicles, engines, and equipment.

**Right to Repair/Modify:**

Protect and advocate for “Right to Repair” provisions that allow consumers the ability to repair and modify their own products or allow a designee selected by the consumer to repair or modify the consumer’s property.

- 🚲 Promote access to parts, tools, diagnostic equipment and other technology that allows the consumer or their chosen designee the ability to repair and/or modify motorcycles.
- 🚲 Advocate for the availability of reproduction parts by third party vendors, ensuring consumer choice in the selection of products.
- 🚲 Monitor California Air Resource Board or any other state, agency or board’s policies on parts approval process and transparency.

**Surface Transportation Reauthorization (Highway Bill):**

Advocate and pursue legislative efforts related to the next highway bill reauthorization (the current act is set to expire 2026). Ensure the following provisions are included:

- 🚲 Promote Motorcycle Education & Awareness Program Grant Funding. (Renewed Every 5 years)
- 🚲 Preserve the ban on federal funding for Motorcycle Only Checkpoints.
- 🚲 Preserve the NHTSA Lobbying Ban and expand to other federal agencies.
- 🚲 Reestablish the Motorcyclist Advisory Council (MAC) to advise the U.S. Department of Transportation. (Renewed Every 5 years)
- 🚲 Preserve motorcycles are not considered single-occupancy vehicles for HOV lane access.
- 🚲 Oppose any motorcycling related federal blackmails or federal sanctions.
- 🚲 Monitor for any action that would negatively impact motorcycles, motorcycling, and motorcyclists.
- 🚲 Advocate the integration of an updated federal definition of a motorcycle.
- 🚲 Advocate a mandate that autonomous vehicles must detect and respond to motorcycles.
- 🚲 Advocate for expanding opportunities to address motorcyclist profiling.
- 🚲 Ensure motorcycles are not banned from federally funded roads.
- 🚲 All high priority MRF Legislative priorities and emerging technologies

**Vulnerable Roadway User Terminology:**

Monitor and ensure that motorcycles and motorcyclists are a specific and unique category or classification.

## 2026 MEDIUM PRIORITY OBJECTIVES

### **Lane Filtering and/or Lane Splitting:**

Monitor and support federal efforts to study and review the benefits and concerns of lane splitting and lane filtering.

### **Taxes:**

Encourage fair treatment of motorcyclists in any change to federal taxes related to transportation. Vehicle miles traveled and other tax proposals must account for the different impact motorcycles have on infrastructure.

## 2026 MONITOR ITEMS

### **Distracted Driving:**

Work to discourage any/all forms of distracted driving.

### **End of Life Directives:**

Oppose any program that seeks to limit the like usage of motorcycles based on manufacture date.

### **EV Incentives:**

Seek fair tax rebate and or credits for the purchase of electric motorcycles similar to those offered for electric automobiles.

### **Exhaust Systems:**

Monitor and vigorously oppose any federal standard proposing stamping and certifying of motorcycle exhaust systems.

### **International Partnerships:**

Continue participation in motorcycle-related activity in the European Union, United Nations, Canada, India, China and other relevant global markets informing the membership of key developments.

### **National Studies:**

Continue monitoring any national studies concerning motorcycles (i.e., Federal Crash Causation Study or MSF Naturalistic Study).

### **Opponents:**

Monitor private and public organizations that oppose the legislative agenda or mission of the MRF.

### **Sound Testing:**

Monitor any SAE Motorcycle Roadside Sound Testing (addressed by individual states).

🔊 Monitor any action by the EPA Office of Noise Abatement.

### **Tariffs:**

Monitor any tariffs on imported motorcycles, parts, or apparel.

### **Tolling:**

🔊 Monitor fair tolling concepts on federally funded roadways and projects supported by federal bonds.

🔊 Monitor any congestion tolling concerning motorcyclists by federal, state, or local governmental agencies.

🔊 Ensure that tolling technology is safe for use by motorcyclists.




